The Elia Wood Paegelow Foundation and the Friends of the Library committee are leading the **"Help Keep the Library Doors Open"** fundraiser with a goal of \$85,000. This amount of money, in addition to what the Foundation will provide, would keep the doors open through December 2018. Cost to operate the library for 20 hours a week through the end of the year is \$48,856.

Costs to operate the library for 40 hours a week in 2018 is \$116,598.

Thanks to this exceptionally generous community, the amount remaining to meet the goal is less than \$34,000.

If you would like to participate in **"Help Keep the Library Doors Open"** fundraiser, a donation card is available at the library. The cards let you choose to make a donation for 2017 and or a pledge for 2018 which would give a tax deduction for two years.

The program was scheduled to end today, however, many kids are close to filling their card, so we wanted to help succeed at the game.
