The Wood Place Library board met last week for the regular monthly meeting, and to review the current hours of operation of the library. When the library reopened on May 22nd, hours on Monday, Wednesday and Friday were 10:00-2:00. Those hours are still working well for patrons. However, the Tuesday/Thursday hours, set at 3:00-7:00 have had much less traffic, so statistics were kept on library usage on those days. After reviewing statistics, the board voted to adjust the Tuesday/Thursday hours to 2:00-6:00 p.m.

We continue to received donations and pledges for our fundraising campaign. The Elia Wood Paegelow Foundation and the Friends of the Library Committee needed to raise \$85,000 to keep the library open 20 hours per week through 2017, and 40 hours per week in 2018. Two weeks ago, the amount needed to meet the goal was \$48,856. As of today, the balance is down to \$27,600. The public support for the library is wonderful, and we are so grateful to everyone who has made a donation for 2017, and a pledge for 2018.

The summer reading program will wrap up on Monday, July 31st. We have been very happy with the response to the Summer Reading BINGO program. We encouraged 135 kids to keep reading through the summer. I want to thank the California Sonic, and the California Pizza Hut for donating coupons for incentives for our program.
