Hi! This is Connie Walker from the **Wood Place Library!**

It's been a very busy week at the library. In fact, it's been that way the entire month of June. In the 15 days we've been open, 30 new library cards were issued (9 of those yesterday); and 1,412 items were checked out. It's likely that over 1,000 items have been returned and re-shelved.

We think Summer Reading BINGO has been part of the draw. We have 110 Kids registered in the program that will end Friday, July 14<sup>th</sup>. Bingo cards are available for preschool (or read-to-me), elementary, tween/teen readers. 5 local Day Camp providers come to the library weekly, and some bi-weekly, to hang-out, read and use the computers. We hope they are creating a life-long love of reading and the library.

We thank our local Sonic and the Pizza Hut Corporation for providing the incentive prizes. The first BINGO wins a medium shake from Sonic, and a full card (16 squares, or books read) wins a personal pan Pizza Hut pizza.

It's a great joy to have the library open and to have this level of activity. It's going to take the effort of lots of people to support the library to keep the doors open until a levy is passed and revenue is coming in. We are so grateful for all the financial gifts that we have been receiving.
