The library will be closed on Monday, January 15th for the Martin Luther King holiday. The remaining four days will be eventful: on Tuesday, we welcome Heidi Porter to the library staff; the library board will meet on Thursday, and on Friday, Nancy Lewis, Asst. Director will retire after 9 years of service to the library.

Next week, I will highlight how Nancy's involvement and dedication has influenced the library, not only as an employee, but as a board member preceding 1998.

The library has refurbished desktop computers for sale right now and they are going fast. For \$75 you get a monitor, keyboard, and mouse with a computer that has been updated to Windows 10 OS. These computers have additional software and are internet ready. We've sold three units this week, so stop by soon, they won't last long at this price.

Thanks to the successful election on November 7th, there are no more memberships to use the library. Everyone that resides in Moniteau County and all the surrounding counties may use the library for free. This includes residents of the new Municipal Library District in Tipton. Libraries that have tax support share their resources through reciprocal borrowing.
