Hi! This is Connie Gerling from the Moniteau County Library

This week, the 18 donated computers were installed on the network. We are so grateful for this generous donation that benefits anyone that uses the library. We also added the donation of Microsoft Office 2016 software to the new computers.

The library provides 14 public computers with printing capability, 4 early literacy computers, and 2 card catalog computers for the public. The library hosts the ESL classes and provides Rosetta Stone language software for learning English and Spanish on the public computers.

The library will be launching new services in February. The first is a collection of 63 digital magazines which can be check-out through the library's website at [www.moniteaucountylibrary.org](http://www.moniteaucountylibrary.org).

The MO State Library provides us with a subscription of Deluxe TumbleBooks; a collection of eBooks for children, which are currently available through the library's website.

Our 2nd new service will better serve families and students in the outlying areas of the library district. The library's upgrade to Premium Tumblebooks purchases access for the Latham, Clarksburg, Highpoint, Jamestown and California schools to have access to 1,100 eBooks for kids kindergarten through 6<sup>th</sup> grade; 550 titles for 3<sup>rd</sup> through 6<sup>th</sup> grade; and 1,000 eBooks for middle and high school students.

These collections contain story books, read-alongs, fiction, graphic novels, nonfiction, math stories, language learning, National Geographic videos, puzzles, games and more. Teachers will have access to teacher resources. And, every book displays the Accelerated Reader, Lexile level and grade level information. This delivery of services will be utilized by most all students within the Moniteau County Library district.

Subway of California is providing a fundraiser that benefits the library. We are selling a card worth \$45 in coupons for only \$10. The library keeps the entire \$10 and the cards are good through 2018. Thank you Subway for your support of the library!
