Committee members are visiting county school superintendents' to provide information how library services will be extended their schools. Committee members are also giving presentations to organizations and government entities in the county informing them of the expanded services that will be implemented with the passing of the county-wide ballot measures on November 7th.

There are only two issues to vote on in this election and they both pertain to the library.

Proposition A1 ask voters: *Shall there be established a Moniteau County Library District?*

Proposition A2 ask voters: *Shall there be a tax of .12 cents on each one hundred dollars assessed valuation for a county library?*

With very few exceptions, taxpayers will be paying no more than a couple would spend eating out in a restaurant.
