The library's Halloween Spooktacular held on Thursday evening, had 64 children plus parents and grandparents in attendance. The kids went through five stations where they made something or did an activity. The staff thoroughly enjoyed hosting the event. And, I would like to thank the parents and grandparents that brought their children to the library for our first evening program for K-4th grades and their siblings. We plan to begin providing evening programs for this age group on a more regular basis.

The library board met Thursday, Oct. 18th for the regular monthly meeting. The September meeting minutes, and October financial reports and bills for payment were approved.

The board approved 2019 hours of operation: they are 9-5 Monday, Wednesday, and Friday; 9-7 on Tuesday and Thursday; and 9-noon on Saturdays. These hours will begin on January 2nd, 2019.

In the Director's Report, the board learned of the necessary replacement of the CPU battery back-up for the computer network, which was purchased in 2011, and was large enough for the amount of equipment it would need to power in case of an emergency.

In New Business, the board approved a bid for Smith Janitor Supplies, to provide supplies, and commercial dispensers for four restrooms at the library. Also under new business, the board reviewed the 2019 Preliminary Budget in detail. The board will look at any changes to the Proposed 2019 Budget in November, and approve and adopt the 2019 Budget during the regular December meeting.

The monthly Board meetings take place on the third Thursday at 1:30 p.m. The board welcomes the public to attend, and public comments can be given at the beginning of the meeting.
