The library board met Thursday, November 15th, for it's regular monthly meeting. The October meeting minutes, and November financial reports and bills for payment were approved.

Sara Jones, County Treasurer, shared information concerning banking methods used by Moniteau County and the 911 board. She provided a copy of a Bid Form and Specifications for Depository Agreement used by the county, when sending out bids for their banking needs every four years.

In the Director's report covered the physical building, technology issues, Circulation & Inventory. In the report on Outreach and Programs, the director share plans for a Grinch-mas Christmas party that is scheduled for Tuesday, December 11th from 5:30-6:45, for elementary aged children and their siblings.

The board also learn of changes to the annual Adult Reading Rewards program, which will become the Winter Check-out Challenge for adult patrons. The revamped program will be more inclusive by allowing the check-out of a movie, in-house computer, audio book, print or digital book earn an entry to win prizes. The program will begin January 2nd and run through February 28th.

The board were also informed of the Summer Reading Program Grant application to be submitted on Friday, November 16th, and proposed improvements to that summer program that will be implemented then.

The board reviewed the 2019 Preliminary Budget in detail in preparation of adopting the Proposed 2019 Budget at the December meeting.

The monthly Board meetings take place on the third Thursday at 1:30 p.m. The board welcomes the public to attend. The Agenda provides time for public comments at the beginning of the meeting.
