The day after the election, the County Commissioners appointed 5 excellent residents to serve on the new Montieau County Library board.

A few days later, a couple from Moniteau County came to the library to propose that they replace all the 14 public access computers. Since then, they have added to their donation, 2 card catalog computers and the circulation desk computer. That was almost as stunning as the impressive passage of the library levy.

Then, this week...the library received a \$25,000 donation to help with the operation of the library in 2018.

To say that we feel blessed is an understatement. Moniteau County residents continue to validate the importance of the county library.
