Do you have an iPhone but wish you could learn to better use all of it's features? A free class will be held on Tuesday, May 15<sup>th</sup> from 9:00-4:00 with an hour break for lunch. If you have a laptop, please bring it to class as well.

Registration for this summers' *ROCK OUT with Reading* program begins Monday, May 14<sup>th</sup>. Summer hours will begin on Monday, May 21<sup>st</sup>, to accommodate evening programs. The library will be open 10:00 to 8:00 p.m. on Tuesdays and Thursdays until August 3<sup>rd</sup>. The library will continue to be open 9:00-5:00, Monday, Wednesday, and Friday, but will remain closed Saturdays and Sundays for the remainder of 2018, while operating on donations.

The summer reading program is made possible by the Institute of Museum and Library Services through a grant administered by the Missouri State Library, a division of the Office of the Secretary of State. This \$7,600 grant provides for special programming, collection development of books related to the program theme, craft and program supplies, two temporary staff positions, and travel expenses to outlying schools in Moniteau County.

For the first time, weekly programs will be provided at Jamestown, High Point and Latham schools. This is in addition programs at eight area daycare facilities, California Head Start, and programs five Day Camp groups, and one morning and two evening programs held at the library. Readers earn tickets for reading, checking out books and attending programs. Thanks to an anonymous donation designated for incentives for the summer reading program, the Prize Plaza will also be open at Jamestown, Latham and High Point schools the last day of their programs with a \$50 spending limit per reader.

The 9-week program begins May 21<sup>st</sup> and continues until July 20<sup>th</sup>, when the Prize Plaza will open at the library through August 3<sup>rd</sup>.

The successful drop-in programming will be held during July to accommodate busy families.
