Hi! This is Connie Gerling from the **Wood Place Library!**

With school starting this week library hours will be extended so kids have access to the library's WiFi to complete their homework on their Chromebooks. Beginning August 21st, the library hours are 10:00-5:00 on Mondays and Wednesdays. Staff will stagger hours to accommodate students so the library avoids additional payroll cost to provide this service.

Petitions have been circulating for signatures to place a .12 cent levy on the November 7th ballot to support a new Moniteau County Library District and a county library. 400 Moniteau County registered voter signatures were needed to place it on the ballot. 674 signatures have been collected and verified by the Moniteau County Clerk. On August 18th, petition gatherers will officially turn in Petitions to have the Moniteau County Commissioners place the levy on a ballot measure on November 7th, 2017.

Now that the Petition signing process has taken place, the Levy Campaign will begin. Laura Burger, Chair of the campaign committee, will hold a meeting on Tuesday, August 22 at 7:00 p.m. upstairs at the library.
